- UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development 2005-2014
- KEY THEME: EDUCATION TO SUSTAINABLE URBAN DEVELOPMENT
- Announced in 2002 following WSSD, Johannesburg
- Lead agency UNESCO / SHS
- Goal
 - Integrate principles, values & practices of SD into all aspects of education











UNITWIN: UNIVERSITY TWINNING Programme was established in 1992.

The UNITWIN/UNESCO Chairs Programme: a way to advance research, training and programme development in higher education by building university networks and encouraging inter-university cooperation through transfer of knowledge across borders.

Today 647 UNESCO Chairs and 60 UNITWIN Networks are established within the Programme, involving over 770 institutions in 126 countries and covering 70 disciplines.





New strategic orientations of the UNITWIN/UNESCO Chairs Programme



The new strategic orientations of the **UNITWIN:UNESCO** Chairs Programme were approved by the 176 sessions of Executive Board in April 2007. The document is focused on the creation of new generation of Chairs and Networks in line with UNESCO's programme objectives and priorities, which will be acting as Think-tanks and as bridge-builders, between research outcomes and decisionmaking, and between academia and local communities.






UNESCO Chairs DISTRIBUTION BY REGION
